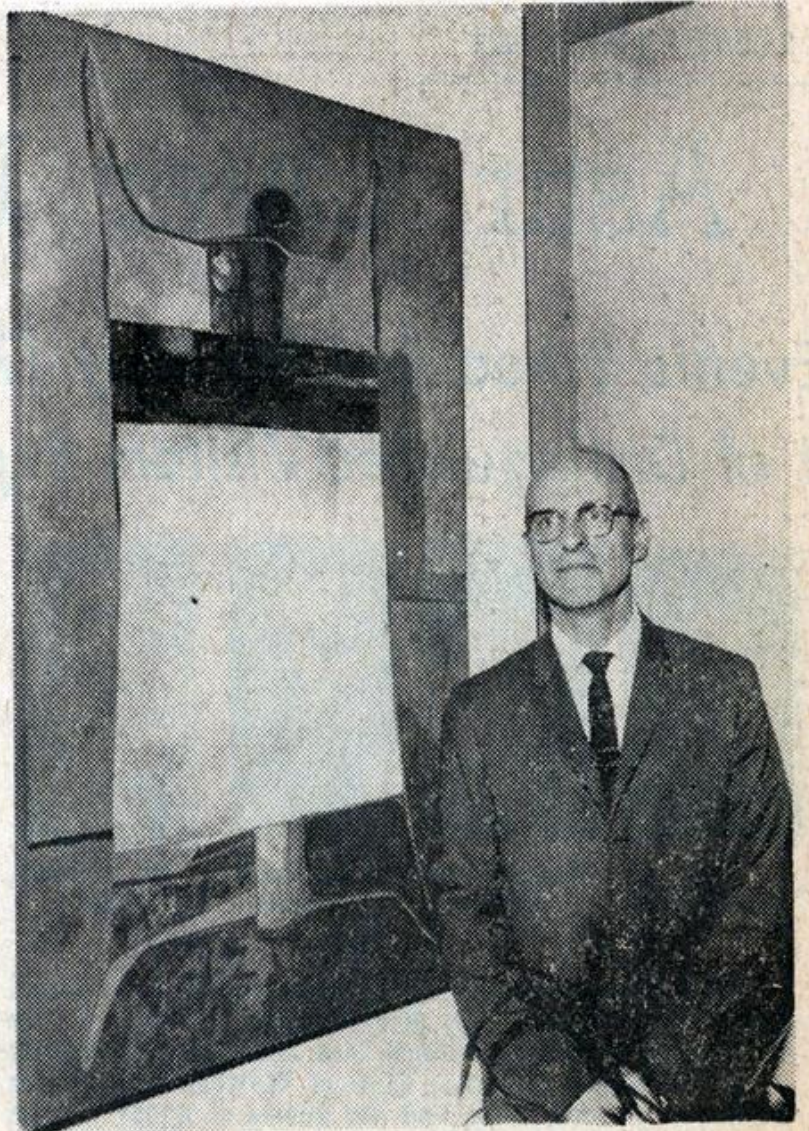
Cornell Artist Receives Juniors Award

A Cornell University art professor, Norman Daly, last night was announced winner of the Jurors' Show Award, top prize of the Rochester-Finger Lakes Exhibition at the Memorial Art Gallery.

As winner, Daly was invited to hold a one-man show at the gallery sometime during the coming year. He has had work accepted in the Finger Lakes in past years, but had not entered for several years before the present show.

Thirty other artists from the 19-county Rochester-Finger Lakes area received awards last night at the preview showing for exhibitors and gallery members. Harris K. Prior, gallery director, made the presentations. The exhibition will be open through June 2.

The Jurors' award is made for the artist's work as a whole, not for a single entry. Daly also won the \$150 B. Forman Co. award to an outstanding entry in any medium, for his oil, "Ancient Symbols." Two other works, another oil and an iron sculpture, also were accepted.
